



The Singapore Law Gazette Awards 2018 **Qualifying Period: August 2017 to July 2018**

In 2013, the Publications Committee of the Law Society inaugurated the Singapore Law Gazette (the “Law Gazette”) Awards for best feature articles.

The qualifying period for the 2018 awards is from **August 2017 to July 2018**. If you are interested in contributing an article on substantive law or a case commentary for the Features section, please write to the Publications Director, Sharmaine Lau, at publications@lawsoc.org.sg

Articles received between now till 10 June 2018 will be considered for publication in the qualifying period for the awards. However, notice should be given to the Publications Director of your interest to submit an article **by no later than 20 April 2018**.

Two awards may be awarded, subject to the decision of the judges and the Publications Committee: “Best Feature Article” and “Best Feature Article by a Young Lawyer”*. Articles jointly written by 2 or more writers will also qualify.

All qualifying articles will be judged based on the following criteria:

1. Depth of analysis, display of thought leadership and whether cited in a judgment;
2. Depth of research; and
3. Writing style.

We welcome article contributions from members of the legal profession, including practising lawyers, law academics, in-house counsel and those in the legal service. Apart from the opportunity to share your views on an area of law of interest to you, you might also stand a chance to win the coveted award.
